Drawing and Painting with Various Mediums

Course Overview

A course for 'a little bit of everything' suitable for all levels of ability with gradual and complete instructions every step of the way for each project.

The course will cover practices using various media i.e. pencil, charcoal, pastel, watercolour, acrylic, pen, and ink that vary from term to term.

You will be sent regular information via email for the medium and theme, prior to each project.

Each project will begin with a drawing and exploring techniques session to prepare you for creating the artwork theme for the project.

The Online Classes begin with 'greeting and introductions' followed by a short pre-made demonstration video for the session.

The Zoom session will then continue with step-by-step instructions, to be followed by you. There will be time to create and reflect on your progress, with the tutor and each other.

A short break will take place halfway through for 10mins, which will give you time to chat with each other and grab a cupper.

Zoom sessions will be recorded for you to revisit with a private link to YouTube for everyone who attends the session. You will be given the option to turn off your video prior to recording if you do not wish to be recorded.

Demonstration videos are made to accompany the online sessions and are available as a permanent resource from the tutor's YouTube channel and Website pages.

You will be provided a ZOOM Invitation or Google Classroom and resources links to the website and YouTube channel in an introduction email prior to the beginning of the course.

Drawing and Painting with Watercolour

Course Overview

The course is suitable for all levels of ability with gradual and complete instructions every step of the way for each project.

The course will cover practices in drawing and painting with watercolour

You will be sent regular information via email, prior to each project.

Each project will begin with a drawing and exploring techniques session to prepare you for creating the artwork theme for the project. Projects may run for 1-2 weeks or more.

The Online Classes begin with 'greetings and introductions' followed by a short pre-made demonstration video for the session.

The session will then continue with step-by-step instructions, to be followed by you. There will be time to create and reflect on your progress, with the tutor and each other.

A short break will take place halfway through for 10mins, which will give you time to chat with each other and grab a cupper.

Sessions will be recorded for you to revisit with a private link to YouTube for everyone who attends the session. You will be given the option to turn off your video prior to recording if you do not wish to be recorded.

Demonstration videos are made to accompany the sessions and are available as a permanent resource from the tutor's YouTube channel and Website pages.

You will be provided an Invitation and resources links to the website and YouTube channel in an introduction emails prior to the beginning of the course.

Recommended colours list:

Cadmium Red, Alizarine Crimson, Cadmium Yellow, Lemon Yellow, Sap Green, Viridian Green, Burnt Sienna, French Ultramarine, Cobalt Blue, Cerulean Blue, Permanent Rose, Opera pink, Violet....the list is extensive so it's nice to pick a few random extras of your choosing as time goes on to add to your collection.

Acrylics for Beginners

We will begin with exploring techniques painting with Acrylic- i.e colour mixing, tint, tones and shade, layers and glazes... Followed by painting a layered 'Bluebells in the Woods' scene.

The Online Classes begin with 'greetings and introductions' with a short pre-made demonstration video for the session.

The Online session will continue with step-by-step instructions, to be followed by you. There will be time to create and reflect on your progress, with the tutor and each other.

A short break will take place halfway through for 10mins, which will give you time to chat with each other and grab a cupper.

The Online session will be recorded for you to revisit with a private link to YouTube for everyone who attends the session. You will be given the option to turn off your video prior to recording if you do not wish to be recorded.

Demonstration videos are made to accompany the Online sessions and are available as a permanent resource from the tutor's YouTube channel and Website pages.

Basic Set of Acrylic paints 120ml Black, White, Cadmium Red, Crimson Red, Cadmium Yellow, French Ultramarine Blue, Cobalt Blue, Green (or similar).

Cartridge paper 130 gsm +.

1 medium sized canvas (no larger than A3).

Paint brushes i.e. 3 flat and 3 round small, medium and large for acrylic. Palette, 2 Jars for water and kitchen towel.

A2 white cartridge paper 130 gsm can be purchased from the tutor 50p per sheet.

Oil Painting for Beginners

We will begin with exploring techniques painting with Oil paint- i.e limited colour mixing, tint, tones and shade, block and blend... with brush and palette knife working towards a Landscape.

The Online Classes begin with `greetings and introductions.

The Online session will continue with step-by-step instructions, to be followed by you. There will be time to create and reflect on your progress, with the tutor and each other.

A short break will take place halfway through for 10mins, which will give you time to chat with each other and grab a cupper.

The Online session will be recorded for you to revisit with a private link to YouTube for everyone who attends the session. You will be given the option to turn off your video prior to recording if you do not wish to be recorded.

Demonstration videos are made to accompany the Online sessions and are available as a permanent resource from the tutor's YouTube channel and Website pages.

You will be provided a ZOOM Invitation or Google Classroom and resources links to the website and YouTube channel in an introduction emails prior to the beginning of the course.

Basic Set of Oil Paints paints 120ml Black, White, Cadmium Red, Cadmium Yellow.

Canvas Pad and/or Canvas.

1 medium sized canvas (no larger than A3).

Paint Knives, Small and Medium Flat Brush for Oil. Flat Palette, Old rags/newspaper, Soap and warm water (for cleaning)

Life Drawing

About the sessions-

The sessions will begin at 6.45pm with the first 15mins allowing for 'Meet and Greet' and for everyone to get ready and finish setting themselves up.

Drawing will begin at 7pm for 90mins with short and long poses, followed by a 20min 'Chat and Review' session led by the Host.

The 'Chat and Review' session will be a chance to show each other your work and talk about different aspects; sharing techniques, styles and generally inspiring each other with constructive input.

Each week you will be sent the Zoom Invitation or via email with an itinerary for the session. One of the poses will be based on a theme or historical artwork set by the host and/or suggestions from the group as the weeks progress.

The itinerary will include a recommended materials list and an invitation to join a private online gallery via the website 'Cluster' whereby we can share our artworks and carry on the conversations from the 'Chat and Review'.

Materials:

Drawing - Charcoal, Sanguine Conte Sticks/Pencil, Pastel, Chalk, Pen and Ink, Watercolour and Brush, Graphite Pencil HB, 2B, 6B etc. Putty Rubber or Hard Rubber

Surface - Sketchpad, Cartridge Paper, Coloured Sugar Paper, Watercolour Paper, brown packing paper, and cardboard.

Tip- Hairspray is good for fixing Charcoal

Drawing boards on an easel is recommended or tabletop easel.
